**Exodus 25:8** "And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them."

**Psalm 77:13** "Your way, O God, is in the sanctuary; Who is so great a God as our God?"

**John 14:6** "Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.'"

**Exodus 35-40** *(These chapters cover detailed instructions and the construction of the tabernacle and its furnishings.)*

**Isaiah 59:2** "But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear."

---

**Ezekiel 18:4** "Behold, all souls are Mine; The soul of the father As well as the soul of the son is Mine; The soul who sins shall die."

**Exodus 34:6** "And the Lord passed before him and proclaimed, 'The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth.'"

**John 1:29** "The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, 'Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!'"

**Hebrews 9:11-14** "But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained

eternal redemption. For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"

**Hebrews 13:10,12** "We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat... Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate."

**John 3:5** "Jesus answered, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.'"

**John 13:8** "Peter said to Him, 'You shall never wash my feet!' Jesus answered him, 'If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.'"

**Ephesians 5:26-27** "...that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish."

**Acts 2:38** "Then Peter said to them, 'Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'"

**Hebrews 8:1-5** "Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man. For every high priest is appointed to offer both gifts and sacrifices. Therefore it is necessary that this One also have something to offer. For if He were on earth, He would not be a priest, since there are priests who offer the gifts according to the law; who serve the copy and shadow of the heavenly things, as Moses was divinely instructed when he was about to make the tabernacle. For He said, 'See that you make all things according to the pattern shown you on the mountain.'"

**Hebrews 9:24** "For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us."

---

---

**Romans 8:34** "Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us."

---

---

**Hebrews 7:25-27** "Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens; who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself."

**John 8:11-12** "She said, 'No one, Lord.' And Jesus said to her, 'Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more.' Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, 'I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness but have the light of life.'"

---

**Acts 10:38** "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."

**Zechariah 4:2-6** "And he said to me, 'What do you see?' So I said, 'I am looking, and there is a lampstand of solid gold with a bowl on top of it, and on the stand seven lamps with seven pipes to the seven lamps. Two olive trees are by it, one at the right of the bowl and the other at its left.'... Then he answered and spoke to me, saying, 'This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit," says the Lord of hosts.'"

**Exodus 25:30** "And you shall set the showbread on the table before Me always."

**John 6:35** "And Jesus said to them, 'I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.'"

**John 6:63, 68** "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life... But Simon Peter answered Him, 'Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.'"

**John 15:7** "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you."

**Psalms 141:2** "Let my prayer be set before You as incense, The lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice."

**Luke 1:9-13** "According to the custom of the priesthood, his lot fell to burn incense when he went into the temple of the Lord. And the whole multitude of the people was praying outside at the hour of incense. Then an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing on the right side of the altar of incense. And when Zacharias saw him, he was troubled, and fear fell upon him. But the angel said to him, 'Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John.'"

**Revelation 8:3-4** "Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand."

**1 Corinthians 5:7-8** "Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us. Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."

**Luke 24:7** "saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.'"

---

**Acts 10:40** "Him God raised up on the third day, and showed Him openly."

---

---

**1 Corinthians 15:20-23** "But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead."

For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming."

**Acts 2:1:** "When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place."

**Hebrews 10:20-21** "By a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and having a High Priest over the house of God."
