

2300 Year Prophecy Worksheet

Question #24 what is the Testimony of Jesus, and what bible text would you use to prove it?

Proclaiming and gathering prophets

- In the bible whenever a time prophecy is given there is always a prophet there to proclaim the prophecy, and then at the time of that prophecy's fulfillment God raised up a prophet to "gather" it or proclaim that the prophecy has been fulfilled. Below is an illustration at how this is true 100% of the time.
- **Proclaiming prophet:** Enoch. Enoch prophesied that the end of the world would come by a flood through the naming of his son Methuselah which means "when he dies it shall come"
- **Gathering prophet:** Noah. at the time of the fulfilling of this prophecy God raised up Noah to proclaim to the antediluvian world that the flood was coming, and in the year of methuselah's death so the flood came.
- **Proclaiming prophet:** Abraham. God gave Abraham a prophecy in Genesis 15:13-14 that his descendants would be slaves in Egypt for 400 years.
- **Gathering prophet:** Moses. After Jacob goes into Egypt the Israelites grow into a nation and as predicted they become slaves in Egypt for 400 years. When the 400-year promise was up God raised up the prophet Moses to set them free.
- **Proclaiming prophet:** Isaiah. Isaiah prophesied in Isaiah 7:14 that the messiah would be born through a virgin. Also, Micah in Micah 5:2 prophesied of the coming messiah and Ballam in Numbers 24:17 prophesied that a star would rise out of Israel
- **Gathering prophet:** AT the birth of Jesus the Messiah God sent to prophets to proclaim the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophets. In Luke 2:25-38 God had to prophets Simeon and Anna there to proclaim the fulfillment of prophecy.
- **Proclaiming prophet:** Jeremiah. In Jeremiah 25:11 God prophesied through Jeremiah that Judah would be in captivity to Babylon for 70 years.
- **Gathering prophet:** Daniel. at the end of the 70-year time period God raised up the prophet Daniel to proclaim that the captivity was at an end. Daniel 9:1-2
- **Proclaiming prophet:** Daniel. In Daniel 9:24-27 God prophesied that 69 prophetic weeks from the restoration of the temple {457 B.C.} The Messiah would be anointed, or baptized by the Holy Spirit.
- **Gathering prophet:** God raised up the prophet John the Baptist. In Luke 3:1-6, 21-23 John the Baptist anoints Jesus as the world's redeemer through baptism.
- **Proclaiming prophet:** Daniel. Daniel prophesied that in the middle of the 70-week prophecy concerning the messiah that he would be cut off, or killed as the sacrifice for sins for the whole world.
- **Gathering prophet:** The disciple John. John the beloved disciple was also a prophet, and at Calvary's cross he was there as a witness to the death of the Lamb of God.

- **Proclaiming prophet:** Daniel. Daniel the prophet also proclaimed in the 70-week prophecy that at the end of the 70-week period the probationary period of Israel would be over, and God would now begin preaching and offering the gospel to the gentile world.
- **Gathering prophet:** Paul. The bible says in Acts the seventh chapter, Stephen the first Christian martyr, was stoned to death. This took place in the year 34 A.D. exactly at the close of the 70-week prophecy, and the bible says Paul was there at the death of Stephen, and in that same year he becomes the great gentile missionary and prophet of God.
- **Proclaiming prophet:** Daniel. Daniel had one great time prophecy left. It is called the 2300-year prophecy. It is found in Daniel 8:14. This prophecy when fulfilled would announce to the world the time of God's final judgment. It stands to reason that according to the pattern there must be a prophet at the time this prophecy would be fulfilled. Who is that prophet?
- **Gathering prophet:** Ellen White. Daniel's last time prophecy would occur in the year 1844, and in the year 1844 a 17-year-old young woman by the name of Ellen Gould Harmon, later Ellen Gould White, received her first vision in which she saw the remnant people of God.
